<p>5. DESCRIPTION OF GOODS: The description of goods must match what is on the invoice. Part numbers, style numbers, and specific descriptions are preferred. Generic or brand descriptions are not recommended.</p> <p>6. TARIFF: For each good listed, an accurate Harmonized Tariff classification number must be shown at the six or eight digit level as required. If a good is subject to multiple tariff classifications, show all tariff numbers. (Remember that the good must be determined to be NAFTA eligible under each tariff number.</p> <p>7. PREFERENCE CRITERIA: Preference criteria are extremely important because they reflect how your eligibility determinations were made. The three most used: A, B, &amp; C. D1, D2, &amp; E can also be used, but under very stringent rules. F does not apply to the U.S. or Canada. A is used when product is "all natural" and comes from the "soil, sea, or space". If it does not qualify under "A", then criteria "B" &amp; "C" should be considered.          ~ "A" 100% territorial origin. Every molecule in your product is of territorial origin.          ~ "B" At least one material or component is of non-territorial origin. (You must have knowledge of the tariff coding system and have verified eligibility through the NAFTA Annex Code 401.)          ~ "C" Produced entirely in the territory exclusively from originating materials. One or more of the materials are not "wholly produced or obtained".          ~ "D" This criterion is rarely used and should be verified by a NAFTA professional.</p> <p>8. PRODUCER: State "Yes" if you are the producer and exporter of the good. If "No", remember to add 1, 2, or 3, depending on your knowledge of the facts and the supporting records you have obtained.           ~ 1 - Knowledge the good is NAFTA eligible.          ~ 2 - A letter from the producer stating the good is NAFTA eligible.          ~ 3 - A valid internal or border ready Certificate of Origin of the good.           Please make sure the answer does not conflict with box #3.</p> <p>9. NET COST: Correct designations are either "NO" or "NC" only. "NO" applies when criterion "A" and "C" are utilized. "NC" applies to goods certified under criterion "B" only if the Annex Code 401 required a regional value content (RVC) calculation under the net cost value method. Otherwise, state "NO".</p> <p>10.
